BACKGROUND

AfWA assessment was conducted in January 2015 using the USAID NUPAS tools and it covered the items below:

- Legal structure
- Financial management
- Internal control
- Procurement system
- Human resources
- Program management
- Organizational sustainability











APPROACH

The results of the assessment revealed that, in general, AfWA has systems in place to properly manage USAID funding. However, the survey identified some gaps and made 18 recommendations to address them

Hiring of two consulting firms to conduct the necessary training of the staff and institutional capacity building in collaboration with USAID WA-WASH staff













Consequently, an action plan detailing AfWA institutional and human capacity development was prepared by USAID WA-WASH in collaboration with AfWA

Implementation of the action plan followed by monitoring and NA-WASH

evaluation







AFWA OBJECTIVE

The training aimed to strengthen the technical and managerial capacity of AfWA's staff. The various training sessions were tailored to allow AfWA's participants to master information technology tools, as well as the fundamentals of project management, grant proposal writing, human resources management, and monitoring and evaluation.

More specifically, the objective of AfWA's capacity building program was to provide the association with the tools to reach its goals.
