Dr. Boukerrou, Director of International Programs and Global Initiatives, has a wide-ranging experience, both in the US and abroad, in international development, project management, training programs design, monitoring and evaluation. He developed institutional and human capacity building programs in several countries including Egypt, Turkey, Algeria, Rwanda, Burkina Faso, Ghana, Niger, Cote d'Ivoire, and the United States.



Dr. Amal Elawady

Dr. Elawady is an Assistant Professor and a member of the FIU International Hurricane Research Center's Lab for Wind Engineering Research and the Wall of Wind research group. Dr. Elawady's academic background is in the field of structural and wind engineering. Her studies involve large-scale wind tunnel testing, wind effects analysis to examine structural response, and design of structures against extreme wind events.
